Since the start over 2,000 racers have participated and with this year's winners, BRDC British F3 vice-champion Jonathan Hoggard and Mini Challenge Cooper Pro champion Robbie Dalgleish, the total number brought over through this initiative totals 20 racers. Amongst the fantastic winners of these prizes is Felipe Nasr, who finished third in the 2012 Rolex 24, went on to race in Formula 1, and returned to IMSA with Action Express. Incredibly in 2018 he was team-mate to that year's winner, Stuart Middleton, with the pair finishing second overall!

The Sunoco 240 Challenge is designed for Am-drivers of all levels. Spanning more than 150 registered drivers each year the winner will race a GT4 race car in the 4-hour Friday endurance. This year's winner Robbie Dalgleish is following in the footsteps of last year's winner Kyle Reid, who proved that jumping from a 130BHP front wheel drive Mini to a rear wheel drive 500BHP BMW GT4 was not an issue. Robbie has had an amazing year winning the British Mini Cooper Pro Championship, the Scottish Mini Championship as well as the Sunoco 240 Challenge but is now up for his biggest challenge ever - the 31 degree banking of Daytona! Will he be able to do it - of course he will, as if you win any of the Sunoco Challenges you have to be very, very good!

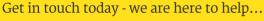
